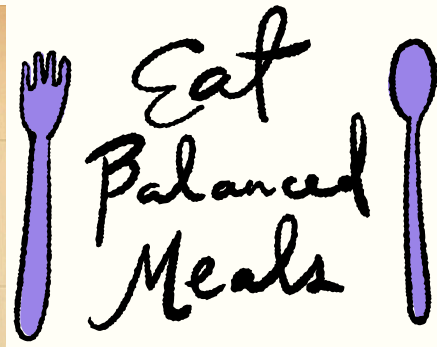


WORLD BOOK DAY

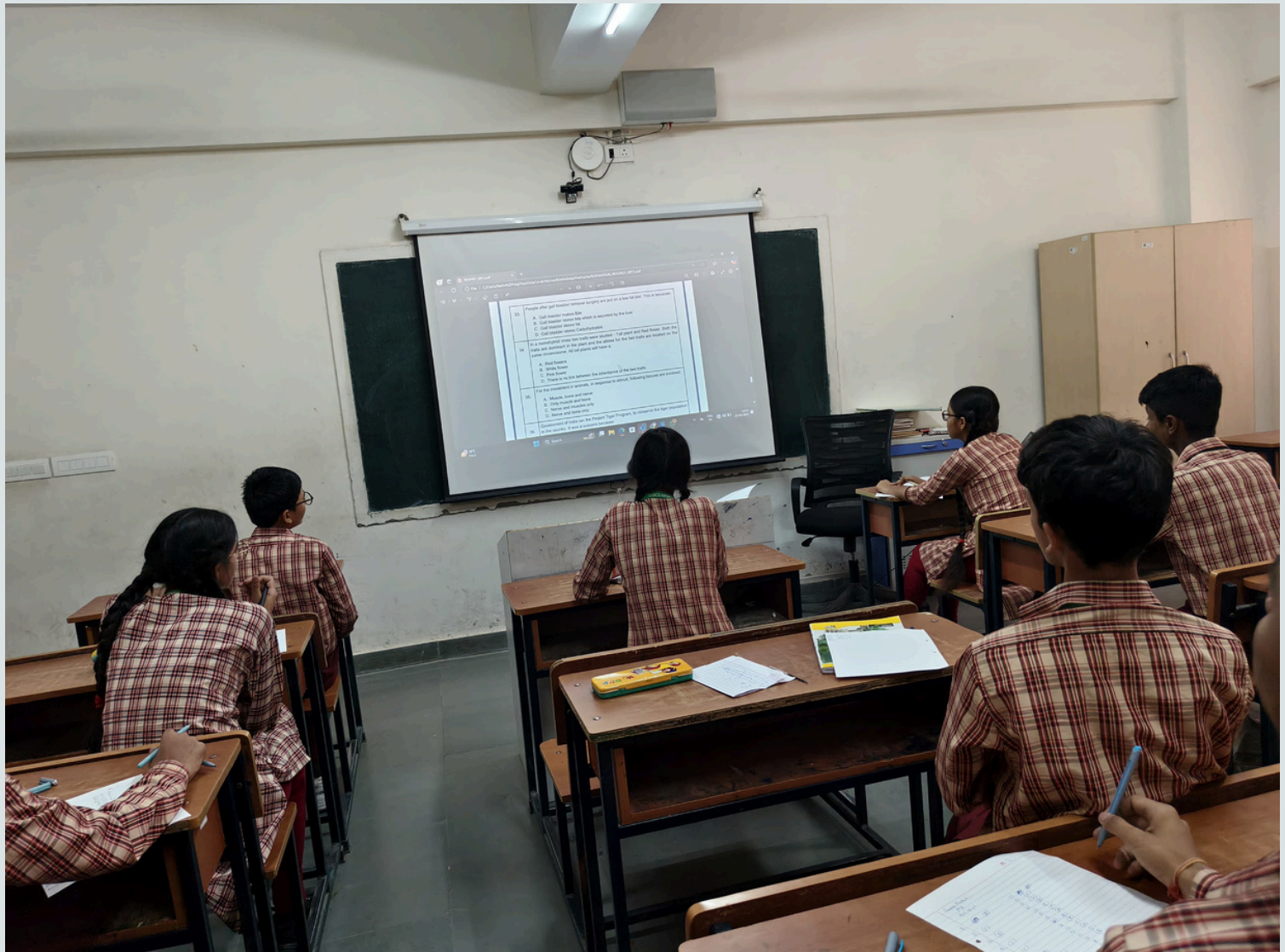


FOOTLOOSE WITH FOLK AND FEELINGS

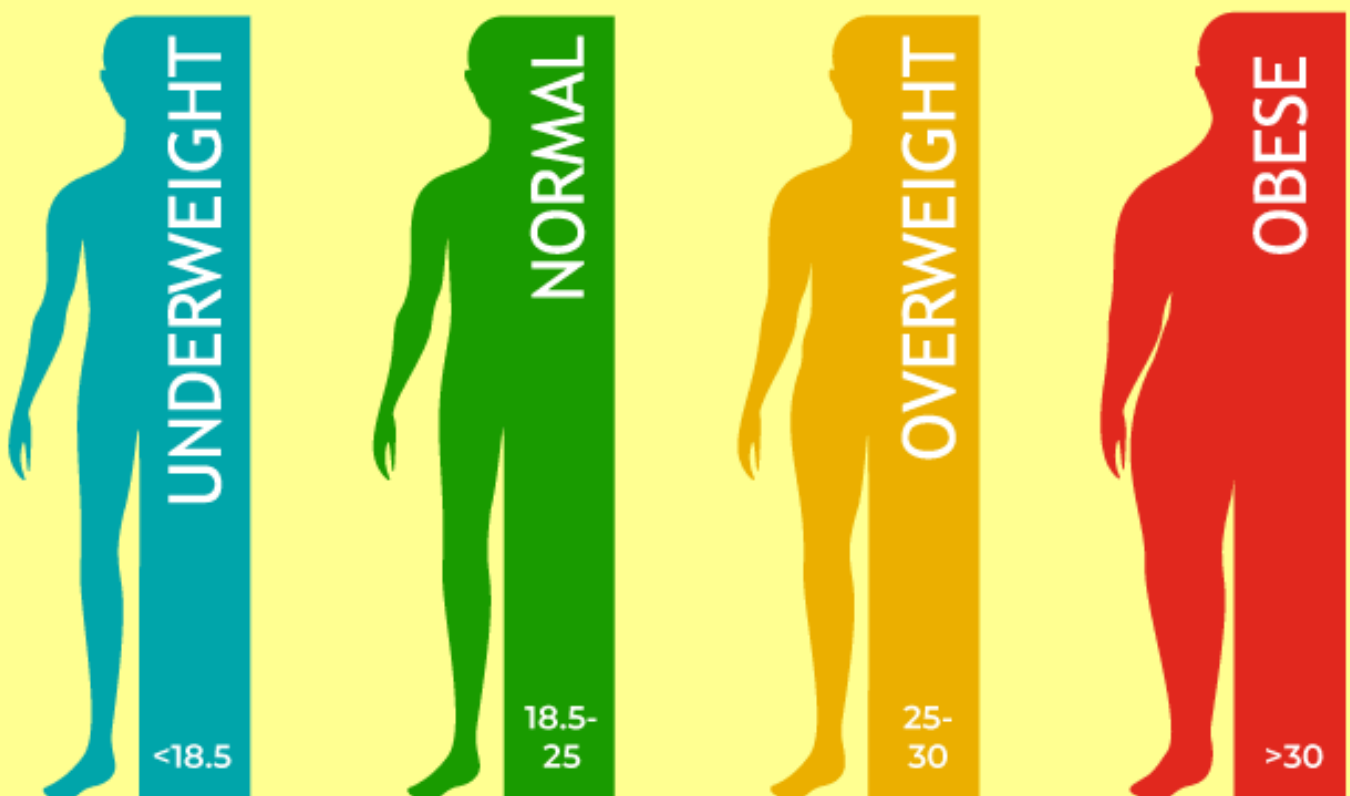

Notebook Checking

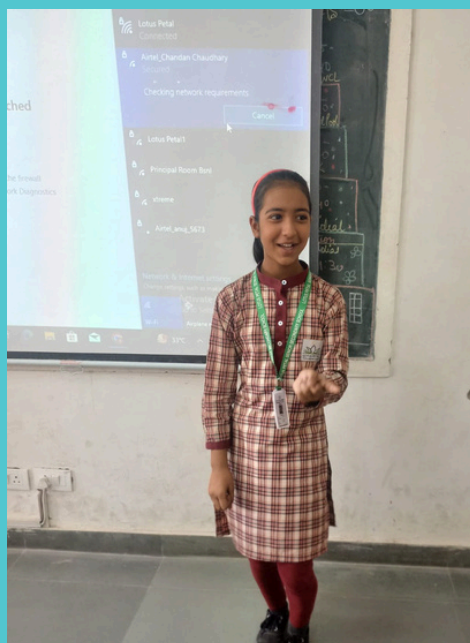

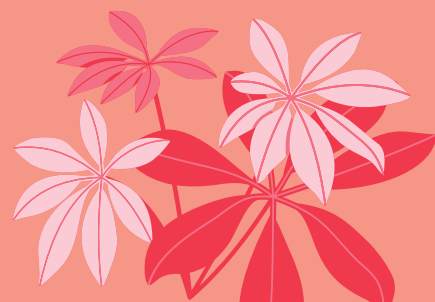
