School Competition

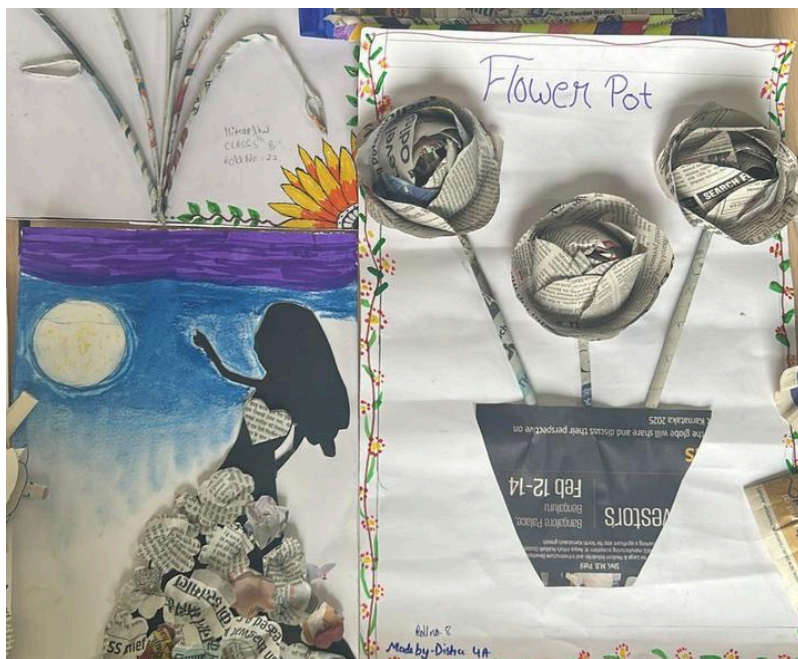
1. Banners That Speak: A Fusion of Art and Wisdom

WORKSHOPS

Teacher's Workshop

1. Bridging Art and Academics: A Transformative Learning Experience



On February 15, 2025, Changemakers from the Senior Wing of LPSSS participated in an offline CBSE Capacity Building Programme (CBP) on Art Integration at JM International School, Dwarka. Conducted by esteemed resource persons Ms. Poonam Chaubey and Ms. Sonali Chopra, the workshop provided valuable insights into enhancing teaching methodologies through interdisciplinary learning. Significant learnings from the session included integrating science with art, utilizing digital tools to support mental health, and implementing rubrics for effective assessment. A highlight of the session was an engaging activity that connected the celebration of Janmashtami with the scientific concept of separation

of substances, demonstrating experiential learning in action. This workshop equipped educators with innovative strategies to create a more dynamic and enriching learning environment for students.



2. Teaching with Impact: The Art of Classroom Management

A key highlight was the introduction of AI tools in lesson planning, showcasing innovative approaches to mental health support. Additionally, strategies

for effective crisis management, family involvement, and professional referrals were discussed to ensure a holistic support system. The session empowered educators with practical tools to create an environment where every student feels heard, valued, and emotionally secure.



Student's Workshop

1. The Power Within: Nurturing Self-Esteem and Confidence

The highlight of the session was the Mirror Talk Activity, where students stood before a

mirror and spoke affirmations like "I am kind" and "I am smart." This simple exercise left a profound impact, reinforcing self-love and inner strength.

2. LEARNING TECHNIQUES FOR BETTER RECALL

To empower students with better recall and learning strategies, LPSSS organized an engaging workshop on Learning Techniques for Better Recall on 6th and 21st February 2025. Led by Special Educator and Counselor Ms. Poornima Sharma, the session catered to students of Grades 7, 8, and 10, equipping them with practical memory-boosting techniques. The workshop kicked off with a Memory Challenge Game, helping students identify their learning styles. Ms. Sharma introduced The Forgetting Curve, explaining how information retention declines over time without revision. To counter this, students explored powerful recall strategies like Spaced Repetition, Mnemonics (VIBGYOR, rhymes, and the Memory Palace), and Chunking to simplify complex information. Beyond memory techniques, the session also focused on Smart Exam Strategies, encouraging students to manage time wisely, stay calm under pressure, and use structured revision methods. The interactive and insightful workshop left students better equipped to retain knowledge effectively and excel academically.



3. Stepping into Tomorrow: Embracing Growth and Change"
