WORKSHOPS


1. Personal Grooming and Etiquette

Ms. Poornima arranged an interesting and instructive session for students on May 18, 2024. The workshop's main subjects were cleanliness, etiquette, hygiene, and health. The session's objectives were to highlight the value of upholding proper personal hygiene and to demonstrate the necessity of thorough cleaning for improved health and a more polished appearance in society. Ms. Poornima covered the fundamentals of personal hygiene at the start of the workshop. She went over the everyday practices that students should adhere to in order to keep themselves clean, including showering, cleaning their teeth twice a day, and regularly washing their hands. The lecture focused on the relationship between general health and hygiene. Pupils were taught the importance of maintaining cleanliness in homes, public areas, and educational institutions, with a focus on our shared duty to do so.
