• Fostering Creativity with Matchsticks and Tea Leaves (Grades III to V)



7. Lotus Petal Word Championship League

In September 2024, Lotus Petal Senior Secondary School (LPSSS) organized the Lotus Petal Word Championship League, an initiative designed to enhance students' proficiency in the English language by expanding their vocabulary. The competition aims to strengthen students' command of the language, enabling them to express their ideas with greater clarity and creativity. The championship comprises tests, conducted every alternate Saturday, with each test featuring 10 questions centered around word identification and usage. The student achieving the highest score each month will be recognized with a prize and certificate. The championship will conclude in February 2025, with the final awards ceremony scheduled for March 2025. Scholarships will be awarded to the overall top scorers from each segment:

- First Place: 100% scholarship, Championship trophy, and certificate
- Second Place: 50% scholarship and certificate
- Third Place: 25% scholarship and certificate.

The first test, held on 7th September 2024, focused on the topic of Synonyms. Students were tasked with finding synonyms for various words using dictionaries. This exercise expanded



their vocabulary, improved their ability to avoid repetition, and helped make their language more engaging and varied.
