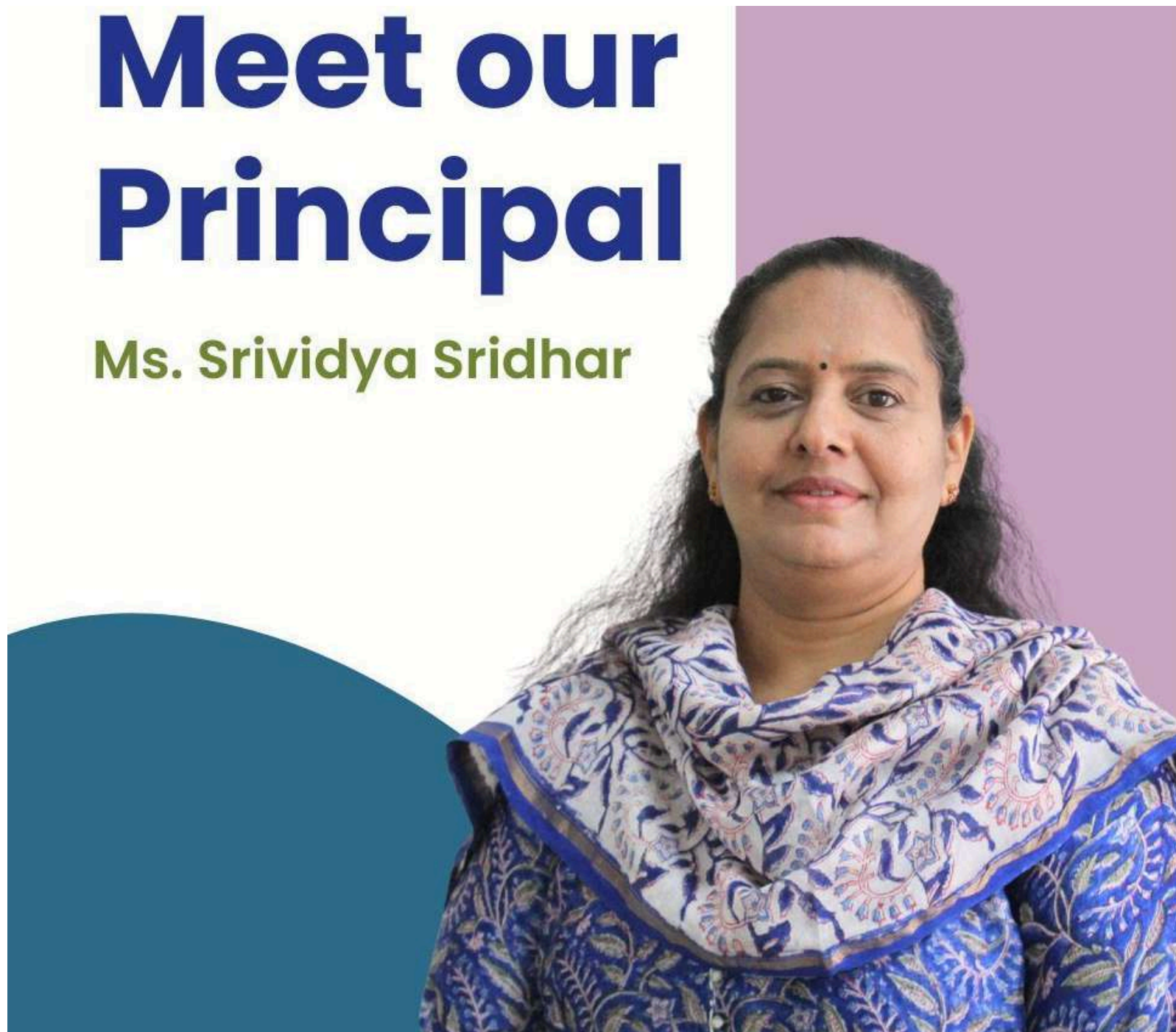

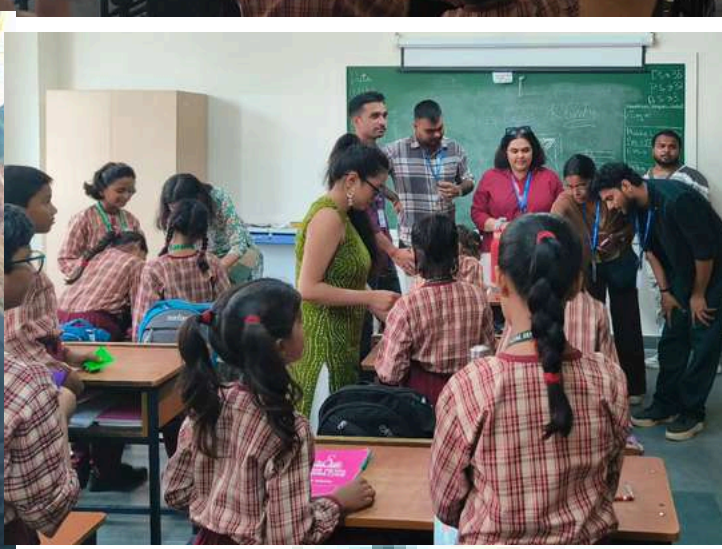


VOLUNTEERING

Students were guided to exit classrooms in a calm and orderly manner. Everyone assembled quickly in the designated assembly area.

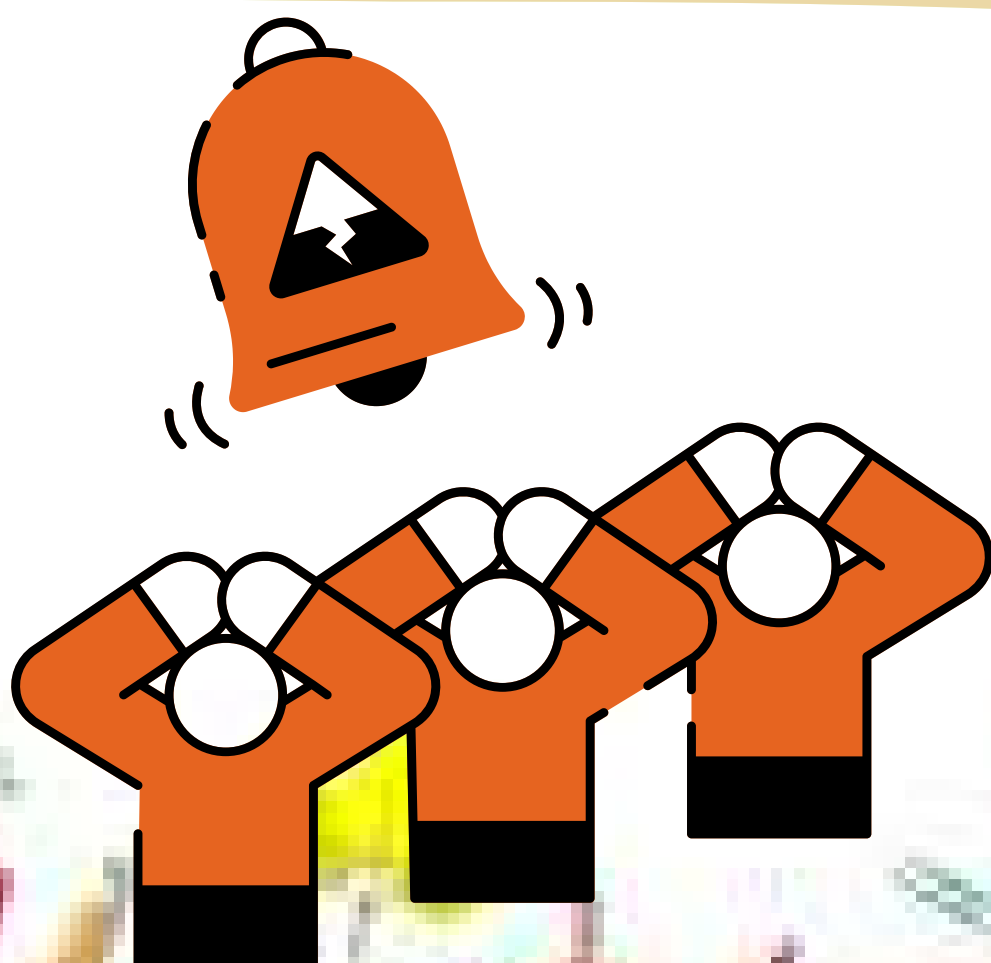
Class teachers conducted swift attendance checks to ensure all were safe.
