Rethink. Refocus. Relearn: Insights from the ASSET Workshop







On 24th, 25th, and 26th June 2025, a three-day post-ASSET workshop was organized for selected teachers to analyze and interpret the ASSET examination results in English, Mathematics, and Science. The ASSET exam, which was conducted in May, provides insight into students' conceptual understanding and learning gaps. The workshop was facilitated by Dr. Tanya Marina Brooks and Mr. Soumya Subudhi from ASSET. During the sessions, teachers reviewed the performance data, identified common misconceptions among students, and discussed areas requiring focused attention. The facilitators emphasized how understanding these gaps can guide better instructional strategies and lead to improved student learning outcomes.

BLOOMING WITH CHANGE: EDUCATORS EXPLORE NEP & NCF

IN HOUSE CBSE TRAINING





On 25th June 2025, a CBSE training session was conducted by Ms. Ruchira Verma, Principal of Lotus Petal Senior Secondary School, on the topic National Curriculum Framework (NCF) and National Education Policy (NEP). The session, aligned with CBSE Domain 3, aimed to deepen teachers' understanding of the key changes and pedagogical shifts introduced in the NCF under the NEP. Ms. Ruchira explained the significance of content flexibility, student choice, and the shift toward a more competency-based and experiential learning approach. She also elaborated on Bloom's Taxonomy and how it aligns with the NEP's focus on higher-order thinking skills. The training included engaging group activities and a quiz, where teachers were divided into teams, promoting collaboration and active learning. The workshop empowered educators to implement NEP-aligned strategies in the classroom, fostering a more student-centric teaching environment.

On 28th June 2025, a CBSE training workshop under Domain 1 was conducted on the topic "Value Education" by Ms. Monika Gupta, Headmistress of the Primary Wing at Lotus Petal Senior Secondary School. The session began with an engaging group activity where teachers were invited to brainstorm the core values they believe every student should embody as a changemaker. Ms. Gupta then provided a comprehensive overview of the concept of value education and the meaning, objectives, and significance of value education within the CBSE framework. She emphasized how value education fosters moral development, social responsibility, and emotional intelligence in learners. Teachers were introduced to various categories of values relevant at different stages of student development.
