WORKSHOP FOR STUDENTS

On 17th April, students from Vidyananda School and the Primary Wing had a wonderful opportunity to attend an informative and engaging Workshop on Health and Hygiene, conducted by Ms. Anjali and Ms. Poornima respectively (Special educators of LPSSS) at Lotus Petal School. The session aimed to raise awareness among young minds about the importance of cleanliness and developing healthy habits in everyday life.

They began the workshop by explaining how students can maintain personal hygiene on a daily basis. They emphasized the significance of regular bathing, brushing teeth twice a day, wearing clean clothes, and keeping nails trimmed. Through simple, relatable examples, she highlighted how

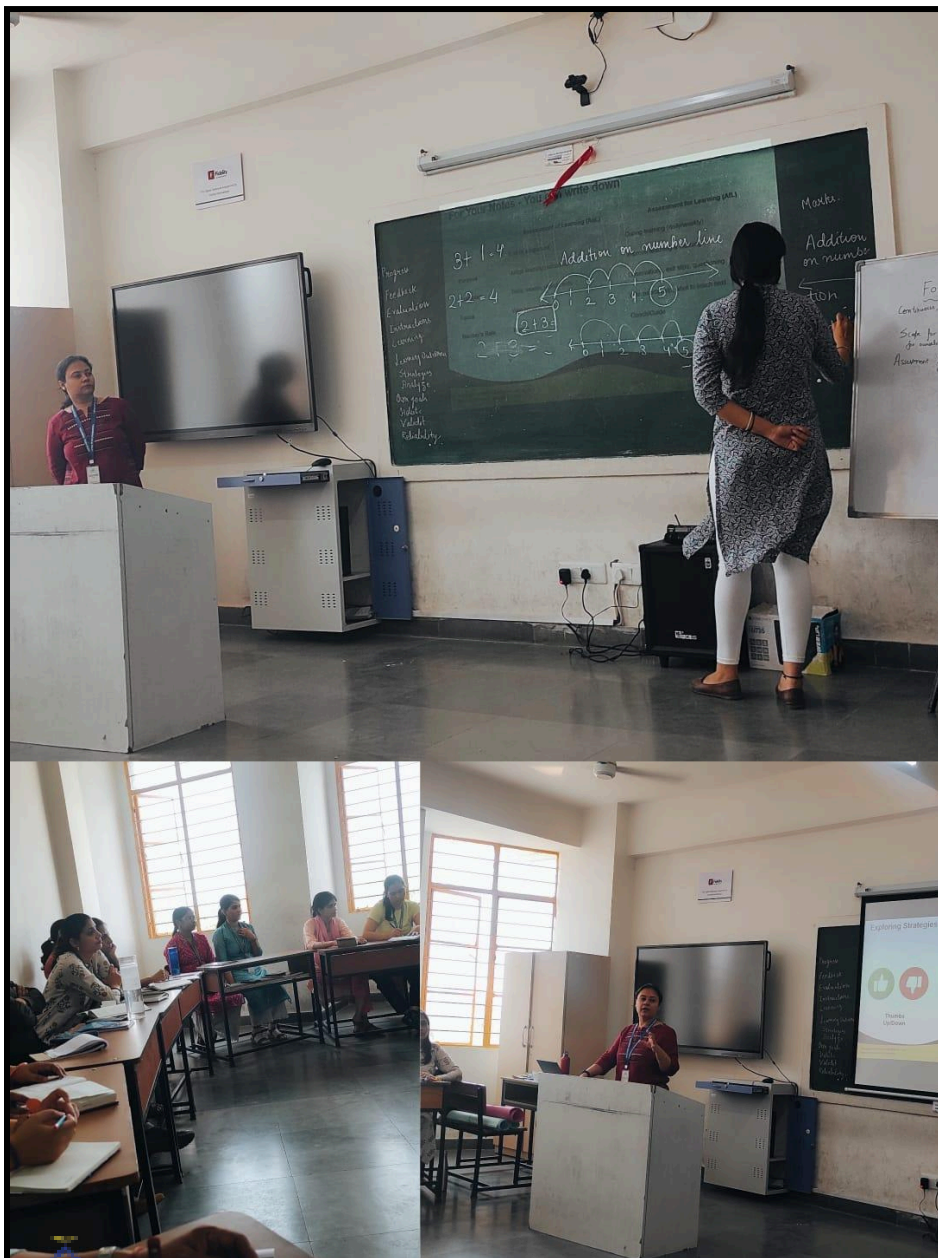
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artworks created during the session are now being used for class decoration.

WORKSHOP FOR TEACHERS



Vidyananda-A

Learning and Development workshop was conducted on 30th April for teachers on the topic of **Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation**, facilitated by Ms. Neha. The session emphasized the role of formative assessments as a core part of assessment for learning.

Ms. Neha explained various strategies to check for student understanding, such as **anecdotal records, exit slips,** and the **"Think-Pair-Share"** technique.

She encouraged teachers to involve students actively in classroom activities using methods like **thumbs up/down, traffic**

light signals, smileys, and the “I do, We do, You do” approach.

Teachers participated enthusiastically in group discussions, shared their insights, and showcased examples of both summative and formative assessments when prompted. The workshop was highly interactive and proved to be an insightful and practical experience for all attendees.
