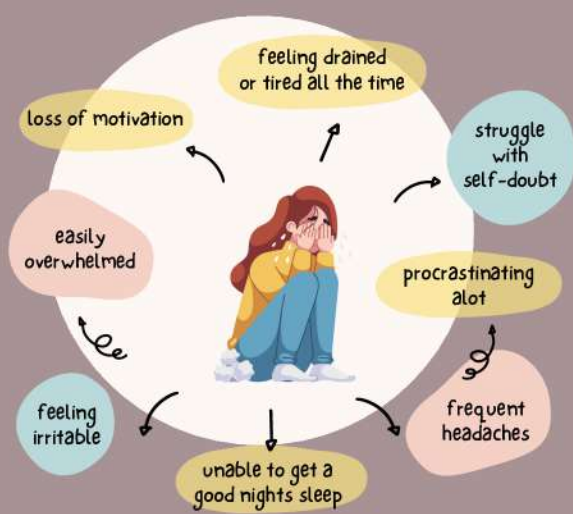
Donor report Training

18 August



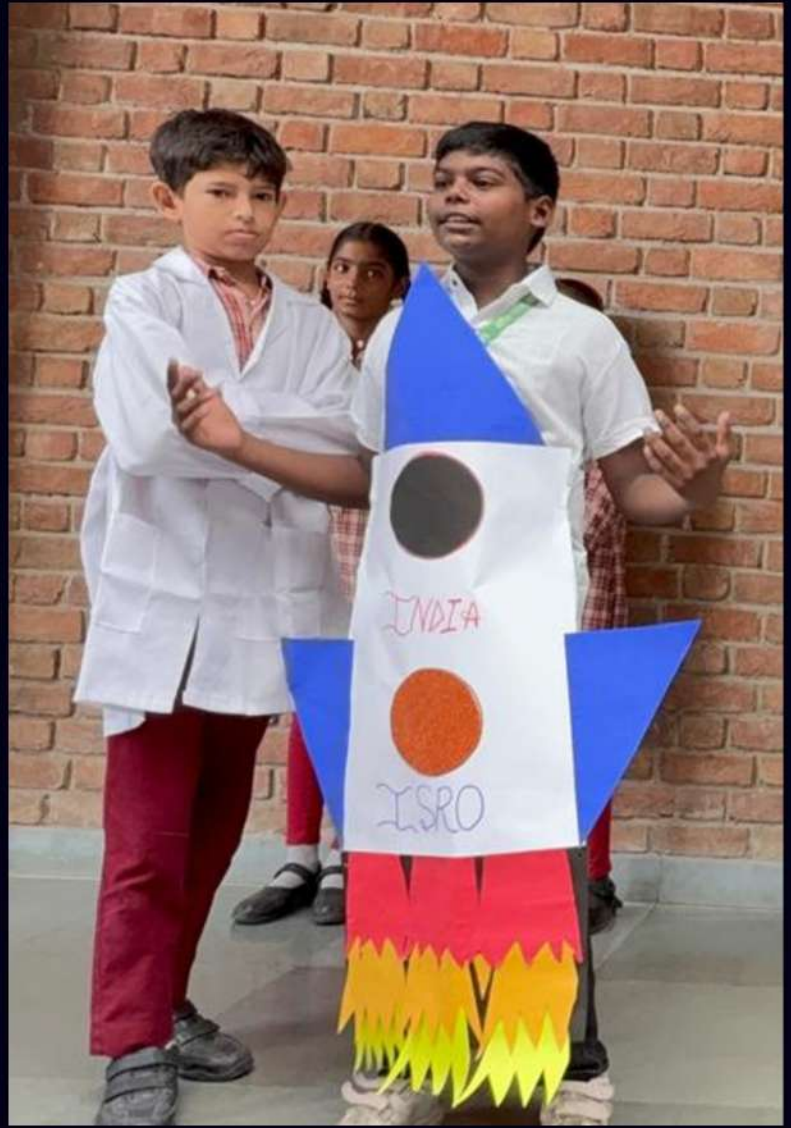

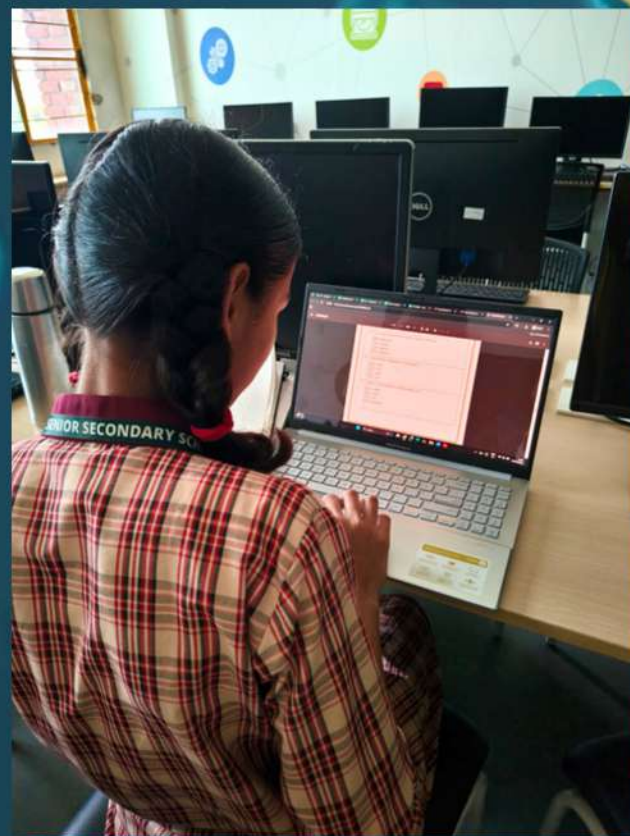
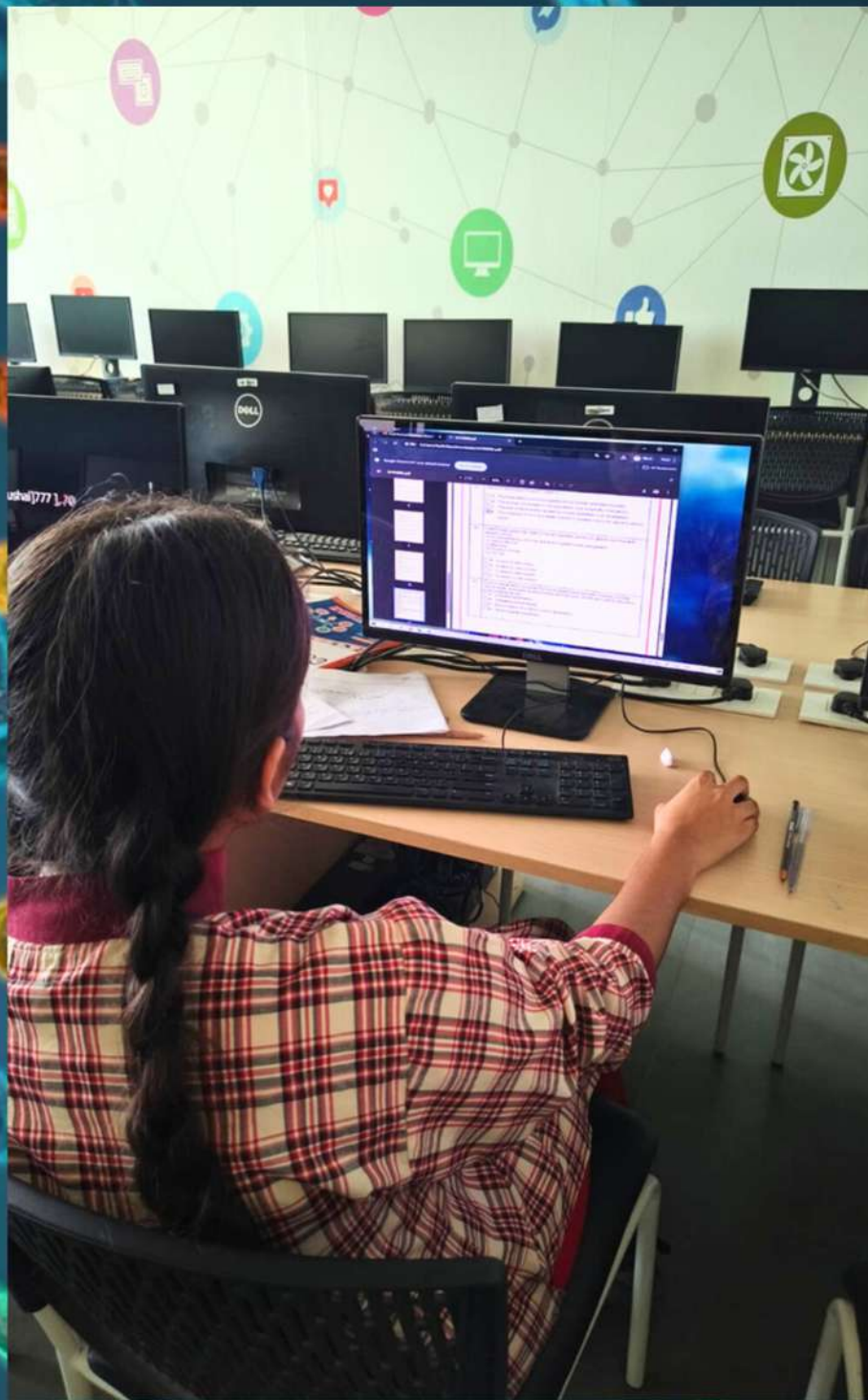




Science Challenge

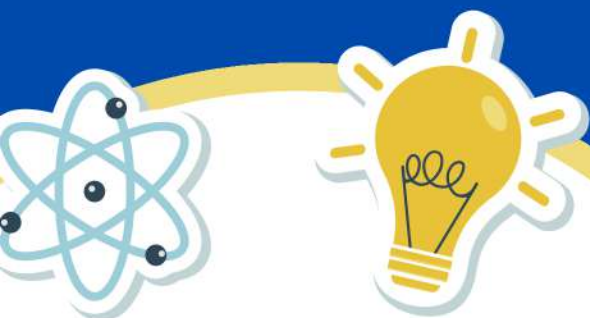
PARENT MEETING
