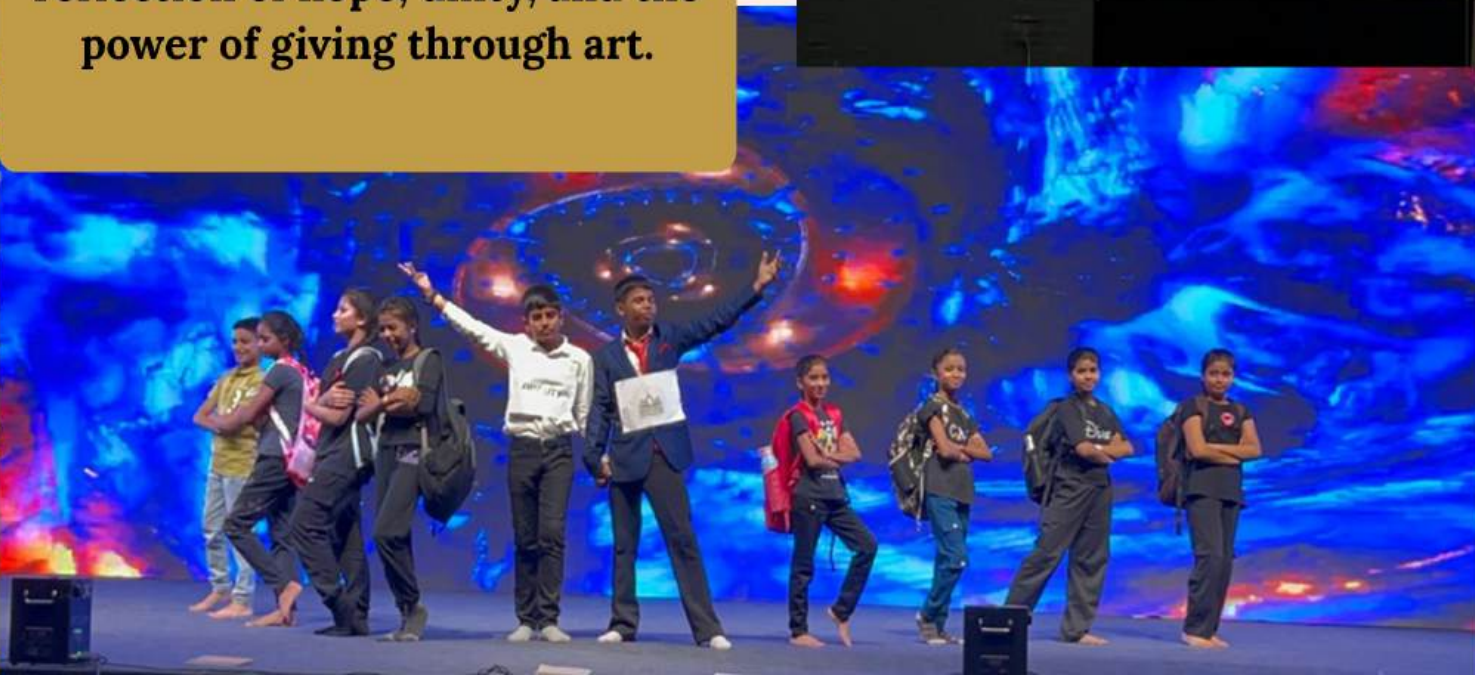


FIDELITY FAMILY DAY

“When passion meets opportunity, magic takes the stage.”



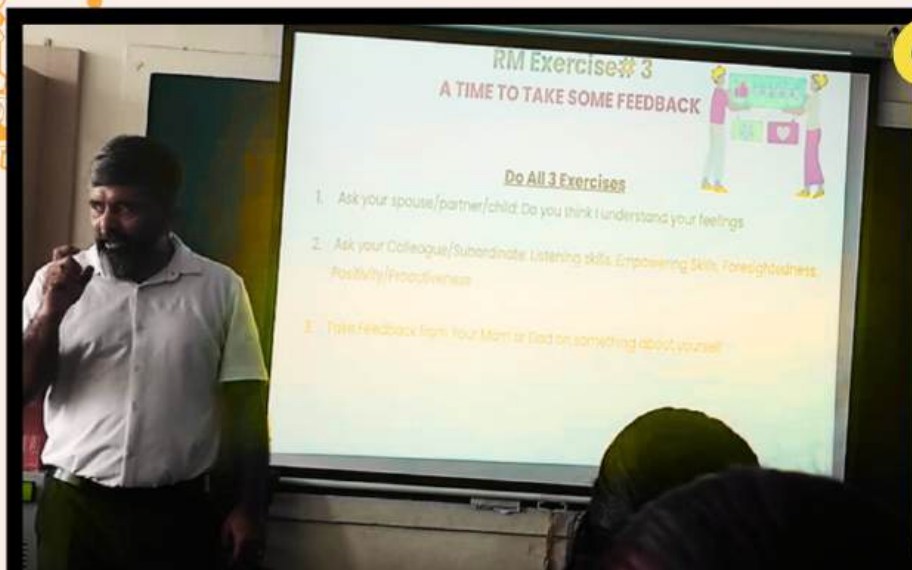

EYE CHECK-UP

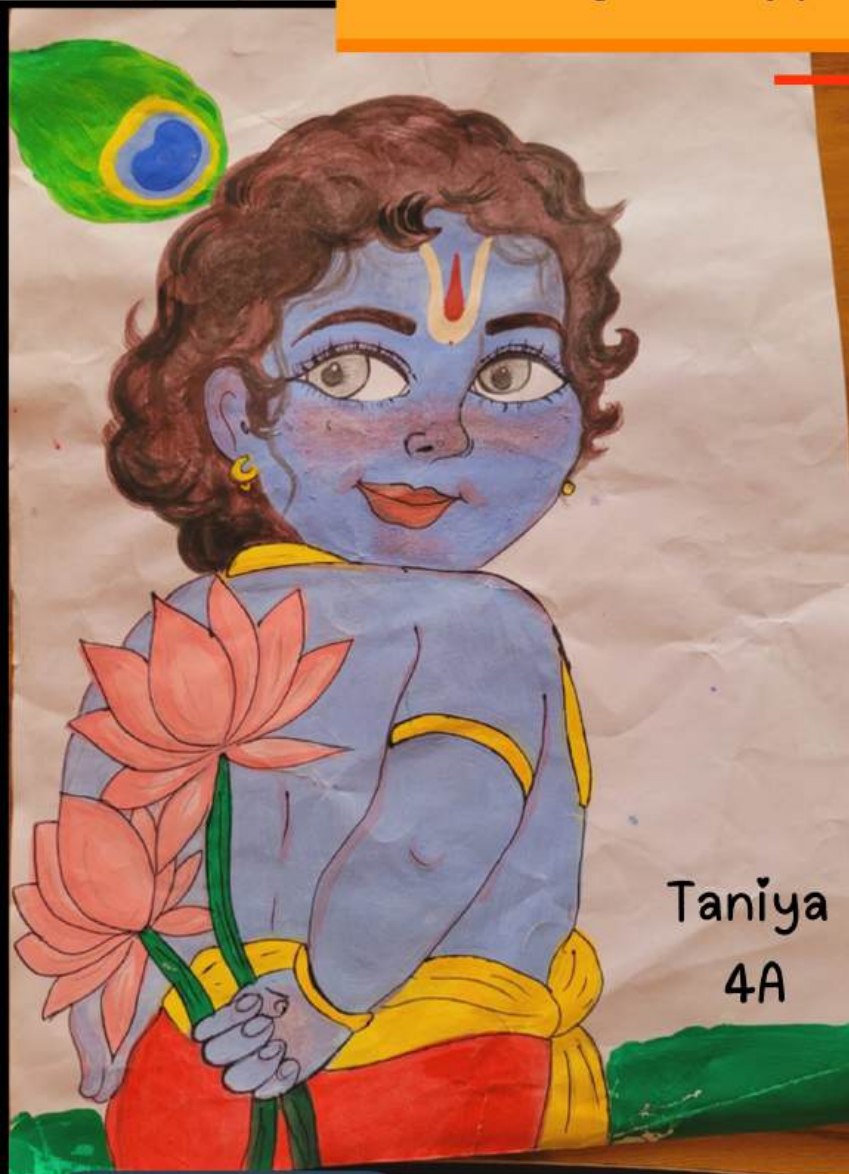
