Admission Policy

1. Objective: The Broad objective of this policy is as follows:

- a. To ensure that the school provides admission to all sections of children from underprivileged backgrounds.
- b. To have a fair and transparent process of admission that is easy for parents and students.

2. Purpose of this policy

This policy documents the guidelines, information, and procedures for all stakeholders for the execution of the admission process. The policy ensures a proper admission procedure with respect to each application received for admission without discrimination on grounds of disability, gender, religion or belief.

3. Eligibility Criteria

3.1 Applicant’s Age – As given in the table below

Grade	Age As on 31st March- Minimum age, Maximum age)
Nursery	3 + years – up to 4 years
LKG	4 + years – up to 5 years
UKG	5 + years – up to 6 years
Grade 1	6 + years – up to 7 years
Grade 2	7 + years – up to 8 years
Grade 3	8 + years – up to 9 years
Grade 4	9 + years – up to 10 years
Grade 5	10 + years – up to 11 years
Grade 6	11 + years – up to 12 years
Grade 7	12 + years – up to 13 years
Grade 8	13 + years – up to 14 years
Grade 9	14 + years – up to 15 years
Grade 10*	15 + years – up to 16 years
Grade 11	16 + years – up to 17 years
Grade 12*	17 + years – up to 18 years

* No direct admissions in Grade 10&12

3.2 Family Annual Income

Underprivileged - Financially weaker section, socially backward (not covered under OBC/SC/ST Category), Uneducated parents (studied up to 12 th or below)	Rs. 5 lakhs per annum or below
Economically Weaker Section (not covered under any of OBC/SC/ST categories)	Rs.1.8 lakhs per annum *25% of seats reserved for the entry class in this category
*Others: including the reserved category of OBC/SC/ST-	Rs. 5 Lakhs per annum or below

This includes a single parent who is educated [may be a graduate], but annual earnings are below **5 Lakhs*

** Family Income includes the total earnings of the Father & Mother/ Guardian [or as applicable]*

5. Seat Reservation

***EWS** is a subcategory of people belonging to the Economy Based Un-Reserved Category, having an annual family income less than ₹5 lakh. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application and who do not belong to any category such as SC/ST/OBC across India. A candidate who does not fall under SC/ST/OBC and fulfils the EWS economic criteria are to be part of the EWS category.

Note: If there is any vacancy in any category, the same shall be filled from other categories, if available.
