
Petal Foundation—from its humble beginnings to the impactful organization it has become today. His words motivated everyone to continue working towards creating opportunities and transforming lives.



All the parents were invited to UTsah, and they were truly mesmerized to see the creativity and performances of their children. Their smiles and appreciation added warmth to the celebration.







The assembly aimed to create awareness among young learners about responsible and safe use of digital devices.




