### b) Yoga and Sports Club

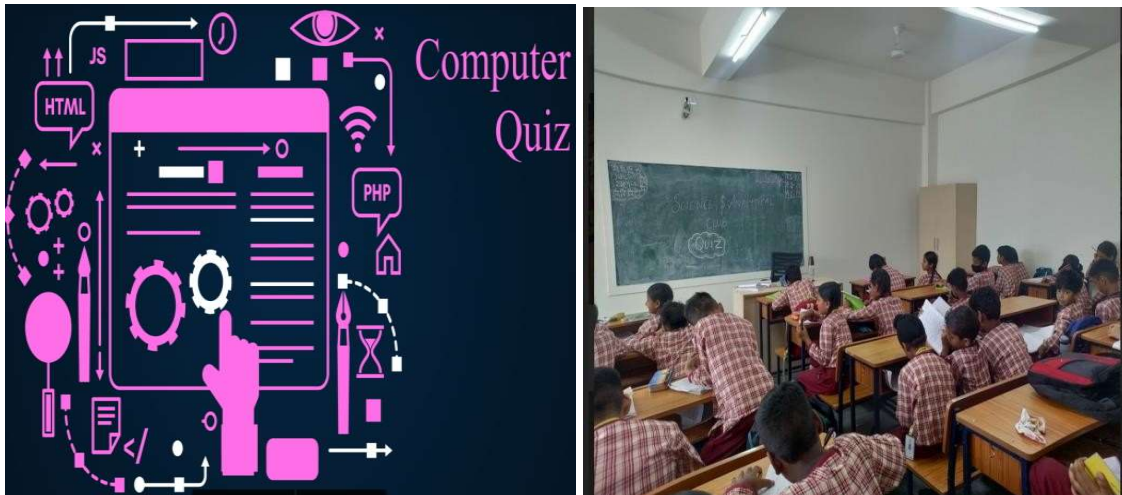
LPSS encourage and support sports in enormous way. Sports Club ensure continued focus on age appropriate sports, physical exercise and health enhancing lifestyle.

## 6. FIRST PTM @LPSSS

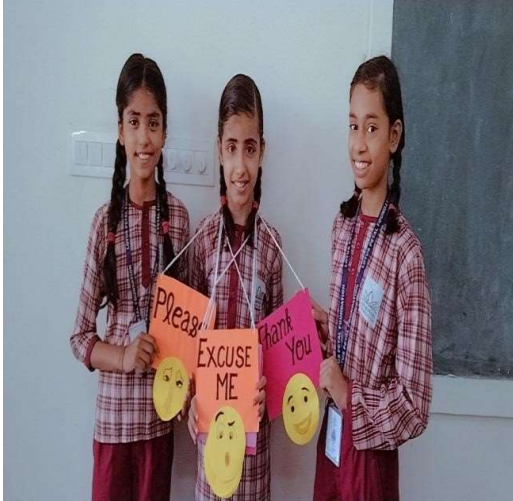
