EVENTS

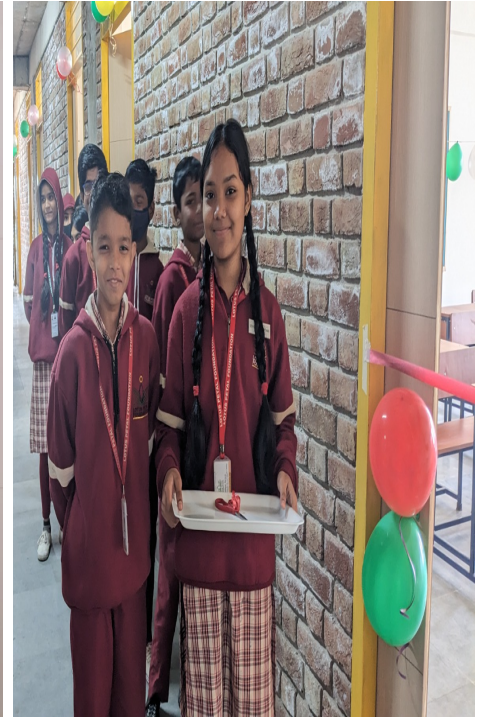
a) ASED Visit

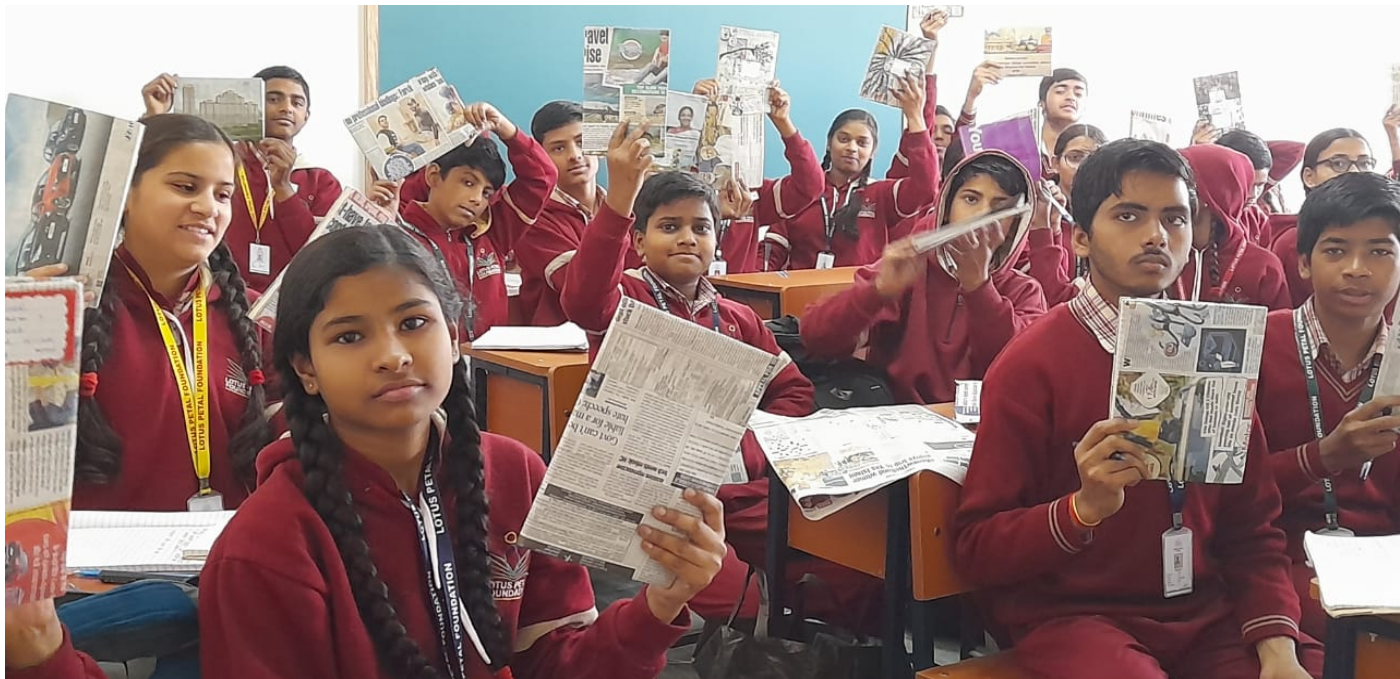
COMPETITIONS

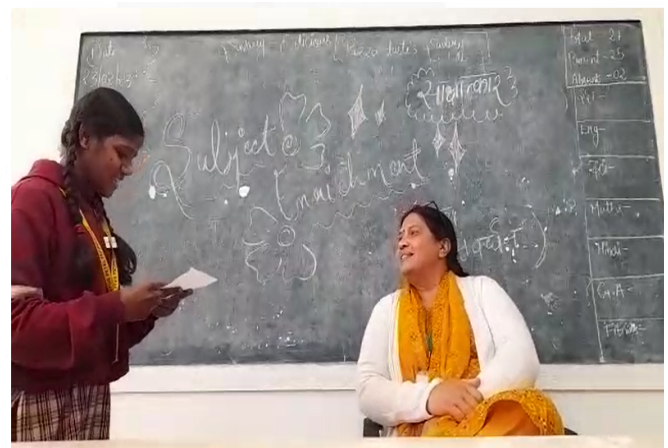
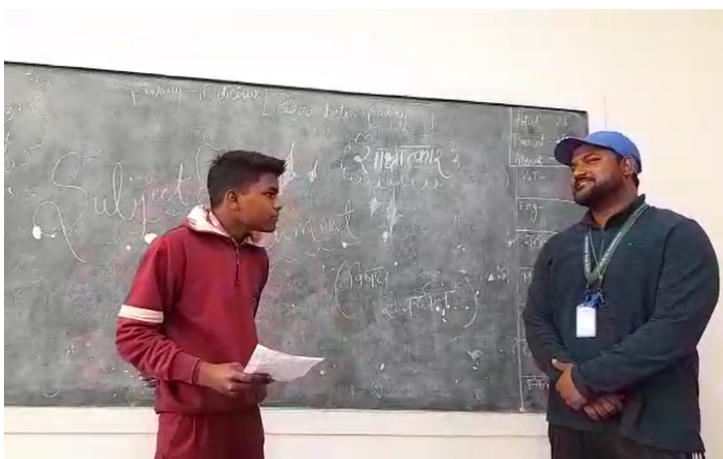




SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY

a) Students Workshop : Anger Management

"Confidence is silent, insecurities are loud."

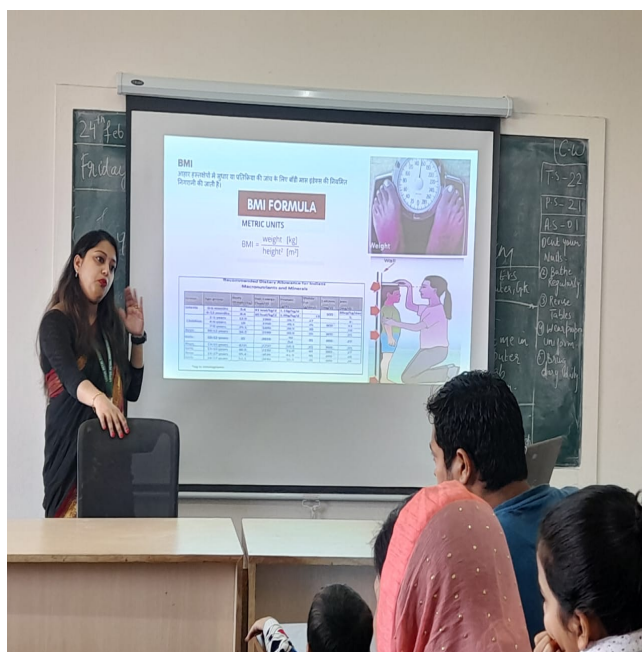
As wise scholars have suggested that strength comes not from throwing a fit of anger but in being resilient to pressure; at Lotus Petal Sr. Secondary school, this thought was further emphasized upon by the School counselor Mrs. Pooja Sehgal in a workshop for students of Grade 2 to 8 on 'Anger management'. Like any other emotion, anger is an important one, however, not well received by anyone as it brings along stress, which is both physical and mental. The session was well crafted to touch upon various aspects triggering anger. Students were made to write about ten important reasons that make them angry, followed



by a reflective exercise. During the engaging session, the curious young learners learned how to identify anger and its various forms, understand its causes and consequences, and techniques to create a sense of self-awareness, introspection, and ways to deal with it. LPSSS has been regularly conducting workshops like this which have been a great source of learning for the students. Such learning and engagement sessions help the students to imbibe the right moral values of life and key life skills which would help them as individuals to become strong and responsible.

b) Parents Workshop : Food and Nutrition - Zomato

Quality and healthy nutrition is crucial for the proper growth and development of children, and discipline when it comes to meals is transferred to other spheres of life, which is also important for proper upbringing. Using these words, a nutrition awareness session was organized for parents on 25th February. More than 300 parents of students participated in the workshop. The opening address by Ms. Alina and Ms. Shalu set the right chords with the parents that they should aim at the overall personality development of the child and not just focus on academic growth. They were informed about the advantages of healthy eating, balanced diet, food pyramid and the various nutrients found in the food items. They were also told that the proper BMI Scanning and meal scanning is being carried out in the school on a regular basis to keep an eye on the overall growth of the students. During the interactive session, parents came up with pertinent queries and were guided well towards the solution.
